# PREPARING YOUR HOME FOR A PROFESSIONAL PHOTO SHOOT



Nearly 90% of potential buyers review listings online as the first step in their search process. These first impressions are essential to engaging buyers, compelling them to act and request a showing. Exceptional photography and video are vital assets in effectively marketing your home and commanding the highest price the market will bear.

### BELOW ARE GUIDELINES TO PREPARE YOUR HOME FOR THE PHOTOGRAPHY SESSION:

### **DECLUTTER, STAGE AND CLEAN**

Building off the Preparing Your Home for Market guideline that less is more, continue the decluttering and staging efforts by addressing the following:

- Remove floor mats and runners.
- Minimize personal effects, family photos and accessories. Remove valuables you do not wish to appear in published images.
- Clean up toys and pet paraphernalia.
- Remove cordless phones, wired appliances, phone chargers, etc., from walls and counters.
- Invest in professional cleaning, including kitchen appliances.

#### **WINDOWS**

Clean dirty windows, inside and out. Remove screens that inhibit natural light and open window treatments so they fall symmetrically.

# LIGHTS

Turn on all indoor lights and replace bulbs as necessary.

# **LIVING ROOMS**

Living spaces should be well-organized and well-lit with limited accessories.

# **BEDROOMS**

Ensure bedding is crisply made and accessorized with limited items on nightstands and vanities. If walk-in closets will be photographed, ensure they appear neat and organized.

# **KITCHEN**

Put away small kitchen appliances. Remove paper towels, cleaning products, trash cans and other visual clutter.

### **BATHROOMS**

Ensure bathrooms are pristine, from shower glass to tubs, sinks and faucets. Stage with crisp, light-colored towels and minimal bath accessories, such as a spa soap, candle and/or small plant.

#### **FIREPLACES**

Ensure the firebox and hearth are clear of debris.

# **EXTERIOR**

- Create a welcoming, clutter-free entrance to your home or condo with attractive lighting and seasonally appropriate planting; clear sidewalks, steps and pathways (of dirt, leaves and debris).
- Clean and place cushions on outdoor seating.
- Open patio umbrellas.
- Neatly stow or remove hoses.
- Tidy up the yard and landscaping.
- Sweep porches/decks.
- Accessorize outdoor spaces with plants or flowers (including tasteful artificial in colder months).
