DONALD: I've been with Mill River for five seasons and have been a club manager for 40 years. I hold a BS from the University of New Hampshire. JOSEPH: I'm a Syosset resident and have been at the club for X years. Before MRC, I was X. I hold a BS from X.

HISTORY AND LEGACY

CAN YOU SHARE THE STORY OF HOW THE MILL RIVER CLUB CAME TO BE? Mill River was founded in 1964 with a clear mission to be a diverse, nonsectarian club. The idea came from William Roach in 1963, who envisioned an inclusive space, equally Christian and Jewish. Since then, we've broadened our commitment to diversity in many ways.

THE PROPERTY HAS SUCH A RICH HISTORY-WHAT CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT THE ARCHITECTURE?

The estate was originally built for Henry Pomeroy Davison II on 134 acres, with a Tudor Revival Mansion designed by Robert Crowie. The landscape was designed by the Olmsted brothers, whose father, Frederick Law Olmsted, is known for designing Central Park and Prospect Park, among other major landmarks. Over the years, the club has made updates while keeping the mansion's historic charm. Eleanor Davison, the original property owner, was instrumental in proposing the golf course idea.

HOW HAS THE CLUB CHANGED AND EVOLVED OVER THE GROUPS AND YEARS?

The club has gone to great lengths to maintain the exterior structure's history and charm.

In the past 8 years alone, we've renovated the pool locker room, snack bar, dining spaces, and added a new irrigation system to the golf course. The club continues to evolve with its members' needs.

CLUB EXPERIENCE AND OFFERINGS

WHAT CAN SOMEONE EXPECT WHEN THEY JOIN MILL RIVER CLUB? New members will immediately feel welcomed by our diverse community. We encourage them to get involved by attending New Member Cocktail Parties and Brunches so they can quickly become part of the MRC culture.

HOW DOES THE CLUB CATER TO **DIFFERENT AGE** INTERESTS?

We've got something for everyone! We host Carnivals, Halloween parties, and holiday









kids and teens, and seniors can enjoy dinners with speakers and even dances.

WHAT AMENITIES AND SERVICES ARE YOU MOST PROUD OF?

Our golf course is top-notch, and we have a skilled professional team. Plus, our racquet program now includes two pickleball courts and an indoor Har-Tru tennis court. Our culinary team, led by Executive Chef Tom Schaudel, is a highlight for members.

DISTINCTIVENESS WHAT SETS YOUR CLUB APART

FROM OTHERS IN THE AREA?

In addition to our driving range where you can use every club in your bag, along with a chipping green and putting green, our facility features a true short game area, which is rare among Long Island golf clubs. Additionally, Mill River Club, often described as a "hidden gem," boasts a secluded location (we're tucked away, which makes us feel like Upper Brookville's best-kept secret); homey atmosphere (members love the club for its home-awayfrom-home feeling. It's low-key and unpretentious, perfect for those who want to relax); and unique offerings (we're known for the "Mill River Plan," which allows members to fund the pro-shop's inventory, offering products at great discounts). Lastly, MRC has nationally recognized pros, Jason and Liz Caron. Jason recently placed 4th at the PGA Senior Championship!







The Blonde Bombshell

After a harrowing rescue, Ali, a 9-year-old Afghan hound, found a loving family in Upper Brookville

THE FAVATA FAMILY on Mill River Rd. has called Upper Brookville home since 1989, enjoying the peace, serenity, and small-town charm of the area. Their property offers plenty of space for their dogs to run and play, and over the years, they've welcomed several furry companions into their lives. One of the most special additions has been Ali, a stunning Afghan hound with a remarkable rescue story.

How long have you lived in the neighborhood? What do you love most about it?

We moved to our home in Upper Brookville in October of 1989. We love the quiet serenity of the property and the small-town feel of Oyster Bay. Our property also gives plenty of room for our dogs to run and play away from traffic.



What's your pet's name, age, and breed? I s there a story behind

Ali is a soon-to-be 9-year-old Afghan hound. Her registered AKC name is Jamna Winsong Martian Alibi, AKA Ali. The name comes

from the breeder's name and her parents' lineage.

How did Ali join your family?

We adopted her during the pandemic, like so many families. We've had dogs for the past 30 years, and she was our second Afghan hound. We showed our previous Afghan in the early 2000s. Afghan Rescue called us in mid-2020 about 5 hounds in Ohio that needed homes. The breeder had passed away, and the dogs were found alone in distress. We picked up Ali in March 2021, and she quickly charmed even the most dog-averse people.

What makes Ali stand out?

She was initially skittish and understandably traumatized. It took almost two weeks for her to sit in the same room as the family. Our other rescue dog, Gracie, a cattle dog mix adopted in January 2020, helped her adjust. Within a few months, Ali was lounging on the couch, playing with Gracie, and barking at delivery trucks. They became very close, but Ali is still shy around new people.

Does she have any special tricks?

Before we brought Ali home, we considered showing her, but after seeing how much she hated the grooming table and her ordeal, we decided she was retired from the show ring.

Any local businesses or parks she loves?

Ali and Gracie attend daycare a couple of times a month at Two by Four in Oyster Bay. Ali is often seen on their Instagram and is called the "Blond Bomb Shell" by the owner.



Top trends shaping the Upper Brookville and broader real estate landscape right now.



1 / TIGHTENING INVENTORY IN THE LUXURY MARKET

The supply of luxury homes in Upper Brookville has decreased by 12% year-over-year, leading to a more competitive market.

Buyers face heightened competition, and sellers may benefit from higher offers as scarcity continues to drive prices upward.

Key takeaway: In this competitive environment, buyers should move swiftly, while sellers can expect strong offers due to the scarcity of available luxury properties.



2 / PRICE TREND INDICATORS HIT NEW HIGHS

Price trend indicators


Key takeaway: Investors may want to explore the option of renting out luxury properties, as demand for high-end rentals continues to climb.

What is your sport/ interest/achievement?

I play chess both at my school and competitively.

Tell us about it. How did you become interested in this?

I started playing chess after receiving a "No Stress Chess" set as a Chanukah present from my grandma when I was four. I was fascinated by the endless possible configurations and began playing multiple times a day. My first tournament was at age six, where I won first place with a perfect score. 

rika Ello, a resident of Upper Brookville, has been making butternut squash soup since the fall of 2020. Inspired by the season and her experimentation with soups during the pandemic, Erika's family quickly embraced this dish, turning it into a Thanksgiving tradition.

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 butternut squash
- 9-12 peeled garlic cloves
- 1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Fresh thyme
- 2 large yellow potatoes, peeled and cut
- 3-4 cups chicken broth (adjust to your thickness preference)
- ¼ cup plain yogurt or sour cream
- 2 caramelized onions
- 2 teaspoons chopped parsley or scallions
- Fresh grated ginger, to taste (optional)
- Pumpkin seeds (for garnish, optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: Roast the Butternut **Squash and Garlic**

1. Preheat the oven to 375°F and line a baking sheet with parchment paper. 2. Brush the cut sides of the butternut squash and garlic cloves with olive oil. Season with salt and pepper. 3. Place the squash cut side

down on the baking sheet. Tuck the garlic cloves and fresh thyme into the squash cavities.

4. Roast for about 45 minutes, until the squash is tender.

Step 2: Boil the Potatoes

1. Place the peeled and cut potatoes in a medium saucepan and fill with water. 2. Bring to a low boil and cook for about 15 minutes. Drain and set aside.

Step 3: Blend the Soup

1. Once the squash has cooled. remove the peel and thyme. Cut the squash into large pieces. 2. In a blender, puree the squash, garlic cloves, potatoes, and chicken broth until smooth.

3. Season with salt and pepper to taste.

Step 4: Heat and Serve

1. In a medium saucepan, heat the soup over medium/low heat until warmed through. 2. Serve in bowls and garnish with yogurt, caramelized onions, and scallions. Optionally, add pumpkin seeds for a light crunch.

- Yukon gold potatoes are used for a thicker texture.


