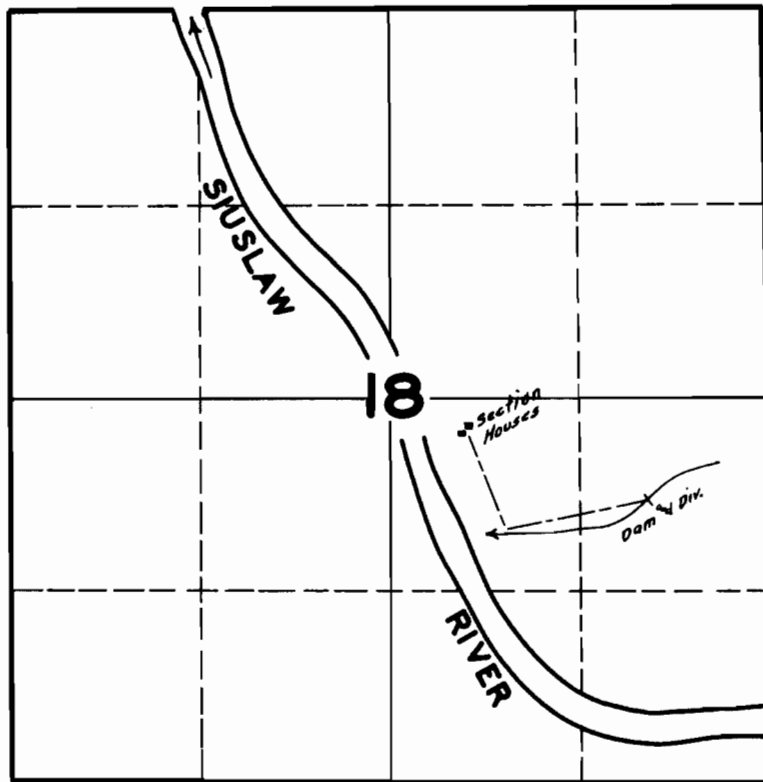

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic supply

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per
second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 24, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1946 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1948

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY

of 702 Pacific Building, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed creek

a tributary of Siuslaw River for the purpose of domestic for one family and crew of ten men under Permit No. 16022 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 24, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 18,
T. 18 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center line of the main line of the Southern Pacific Company's Coos Bay Branch, said point being Engineers Station "D" 1919+11.2 and bearing South 47° 14' 45" East a distance of 3689.94 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 8 West, W.M., Lane County, Oregon; thence North 66° 01' 30" East a distance of 50.0 feet to a point in the northeasterly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Company's Coos Bay Branch, said point being the actual point of beginning of this description; thence South 23° 58' 30" East along said right of way line a distance of 80.0 feet to a point which is 50.0 feet Northeasterly from and at right angles to E.S. "D" 1918+31.2 of said center line; thence continuing along said right of way line on a taper curve to the right long chord bearing South 23° 41' 49" East a distance of 120.64 feet to a point; thence North 66° 46' 30" East a distance of 80.0 feet to a point; thence on a parallel taper curve to the left always 80.0 feet Northeasterly from said right of way line long chord bearing North 23° 41' 40" West a distance of 121.70 feet to a point, said point being at right angles to and 130.0 feet Northeasterly from E.S. "D" 1918+31.2 of said center line; thence North 23° 58' 30" West always parallel with and 80.0 feet Northeasterly from said right of way line a distance of 80.0 feet to a point, said point being at right angles to and 130.0 feet Northeasterly from E.S. "D" 1919+11.2 of said center line; thence South 66° 01' 30" West a distance of 80.0 feet to the point of beginning, all lying and being in Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 8 West, W.M., Lane County, Oregon, and containing 0.369 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
