#### 4. Diverse Living Options



# **True 55+ Communities**

Age-restricted communities where at least one resident must be 55 or older, and no children under 18 can live permanently. These communities are designed specifically for retirees and offer various amenities and services.



# Fee Simple Ownership

These include condos, townhomes, and standalone homes that may or may not be 55+ restricted. They offer the freedom of ownership with varying levels of maintenance provided by the homeowners' association (HOA).



# **Hybrid Communities**

In these communities, you own the structure but lease the land it sits on. Many homes in these communities are single level, manufactured homes, offering a unique and flexible living arrangement.



#### **Rental Communities**

These are 55+ communities where you sign a lease for your residence. They often offer comprehensive maintenance services and community amenities.


















### **Central Gig Harbor**

- -Jasmine Court: 11 units in downtown Gig Harbor, built in 2012 (Shaw Ln, Gig Harbor 98335)

- -Hennington Place: 8 unit condo building, built in 1983 each owns a 50' boat slip. (N Harborview Dr, Gig Harbor, WA 98332)
- -Harbor End Condos: 6 single-level condos, built in 201 with extensive exterior maintenance covered. (31st Avenue Ct NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98332)
- -Harbor Crest: 30 units, built in 1975, 80 & 86 (Harbor Crest Ct NW, Gig Harbor, Wa 98332)
- -Rosedale Village: 55+ rental community single-level homes and comprehensive maintenance services. 161 homes \$2.8K-\$3.6K monthly. (4203 Rosedale St NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98335)

# **South Gig Harbor**

- -Cherry Lane: 6 units, built in 2007 (62nd St NW, Gig Harbor, Wa 98335)
- -**Legacy by Rush:** 62 units, built in 2016. Front yard maintenance only. (72nd St, Gig Harbor, Wa 98335)
- -Quiet Forest Park: Affordable fee-simple condos with full exterior maintenance. 36 units built in 1988 (behind GH Library off of 45th St Ct)

- -Madrona Woods: Gated 55+ community with single-level condos and golf course access. 52 units, built in 1998. Include 2 car + golf cart garage. (21st Ave NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98335)
- -Trellis Grove: A luxurious gated community with single-level homes. Very close to the Narrows Bridge for easy access to Tacoma, SeaTac Airport etc. 44 units, built in 1998 (26th Street Ct NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98335)
  - -Narrows View & Point Evans Condos: Stunning views, mid-range price points, and easy access to Highway 16.
