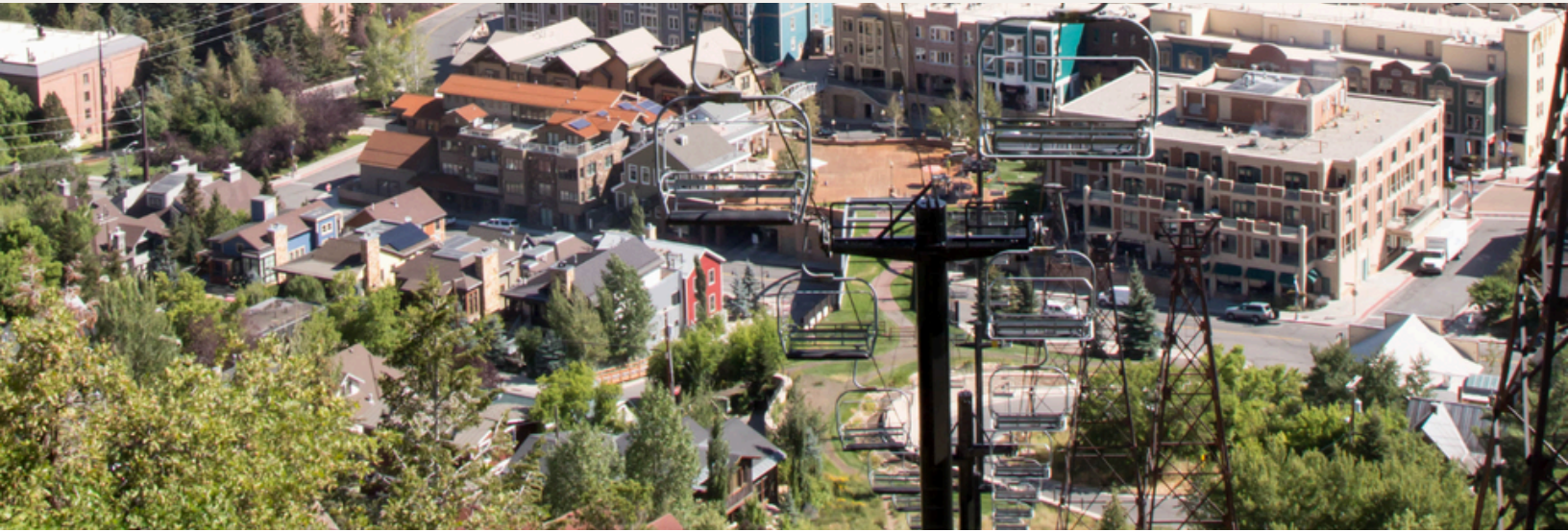

JOB MARKET

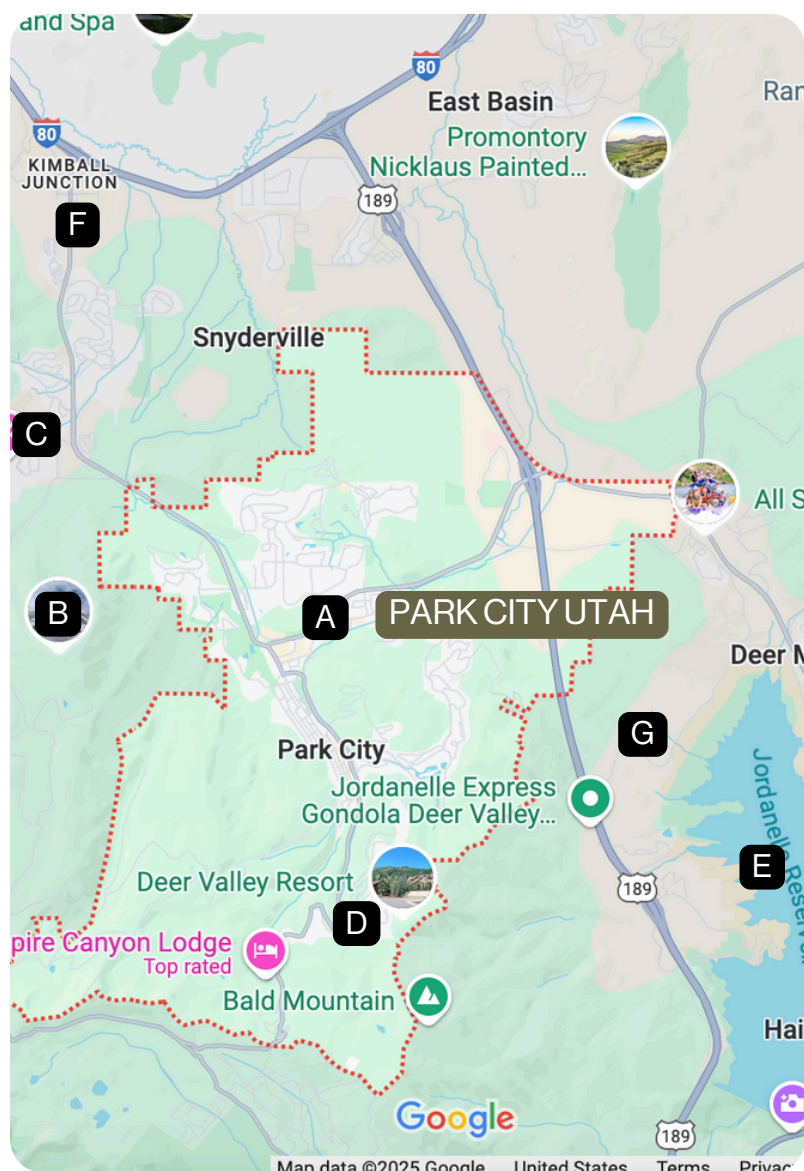

Park City offers strong community support with services like the Park City Library, free public transit, arts programs, and nonprofits such as the Christian Center of Park City and the Park City Community Foundation.

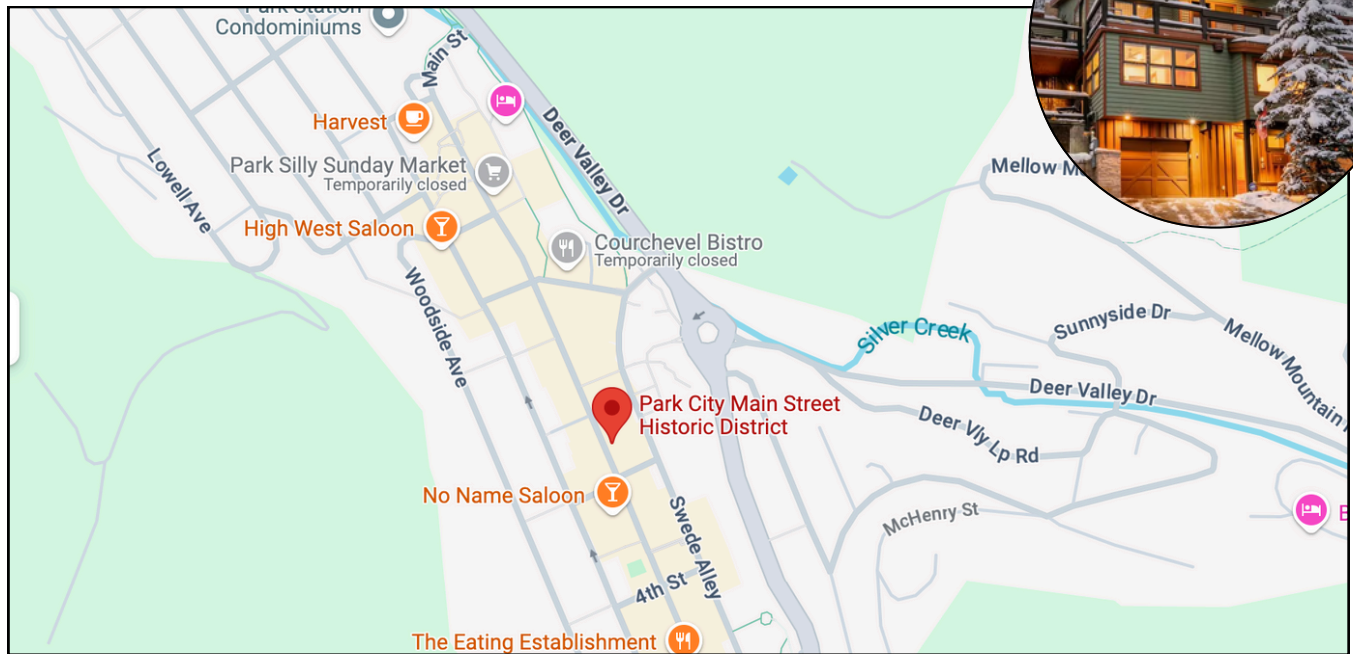
Bozeman At a Glance

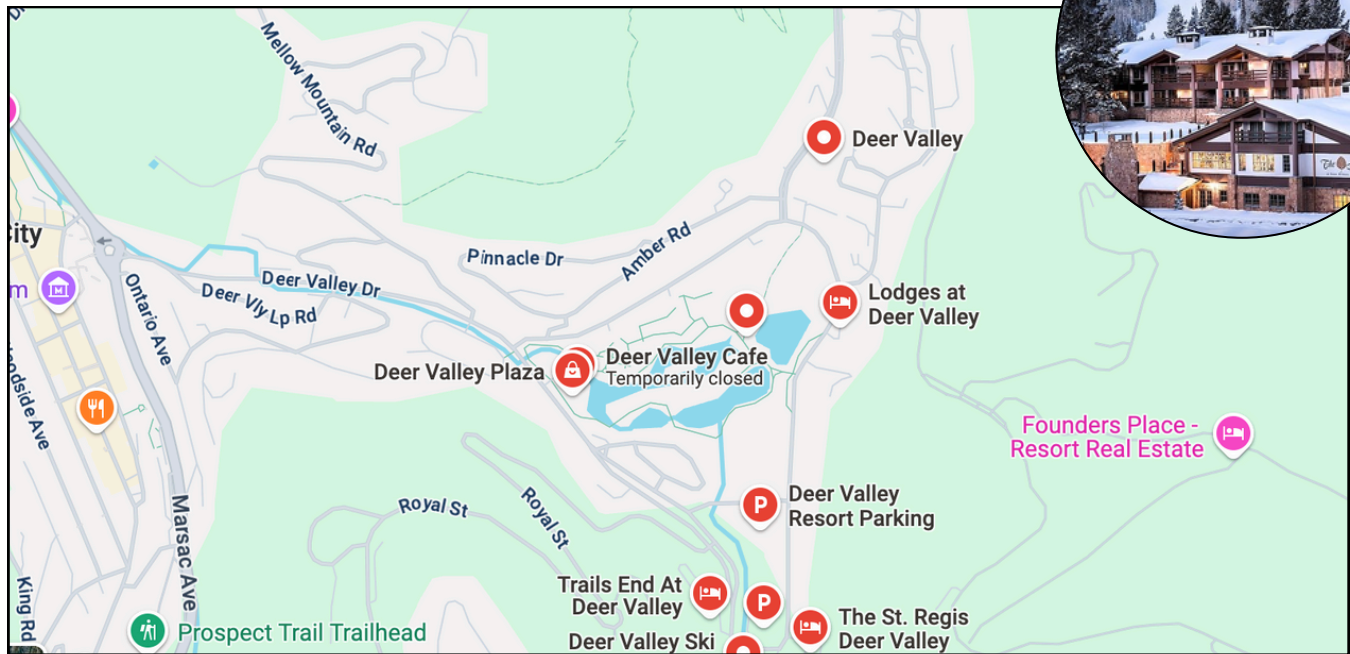


Key Characteristics

Deer Valley Area

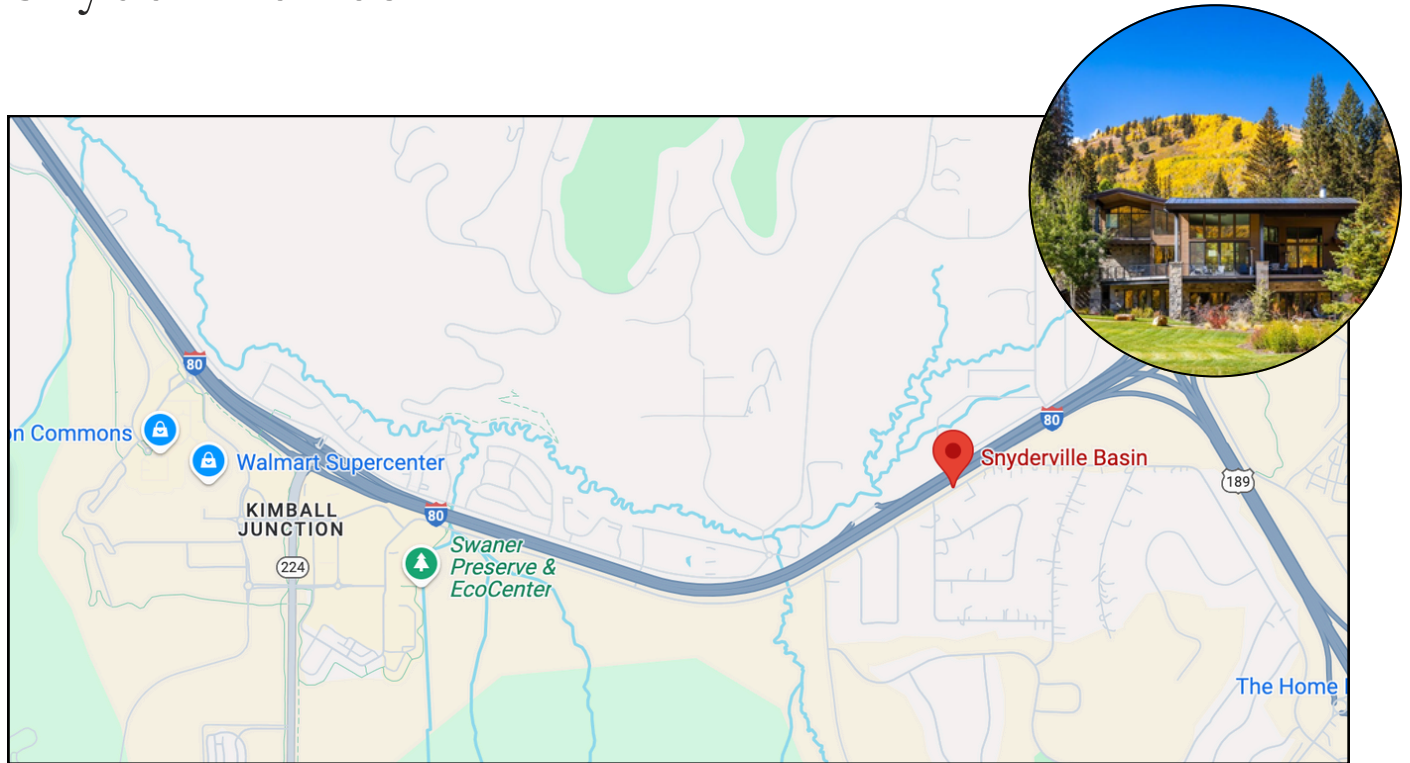

- Red Cloud – An intimate, high-elevation community with luxury homes and direct ski access.

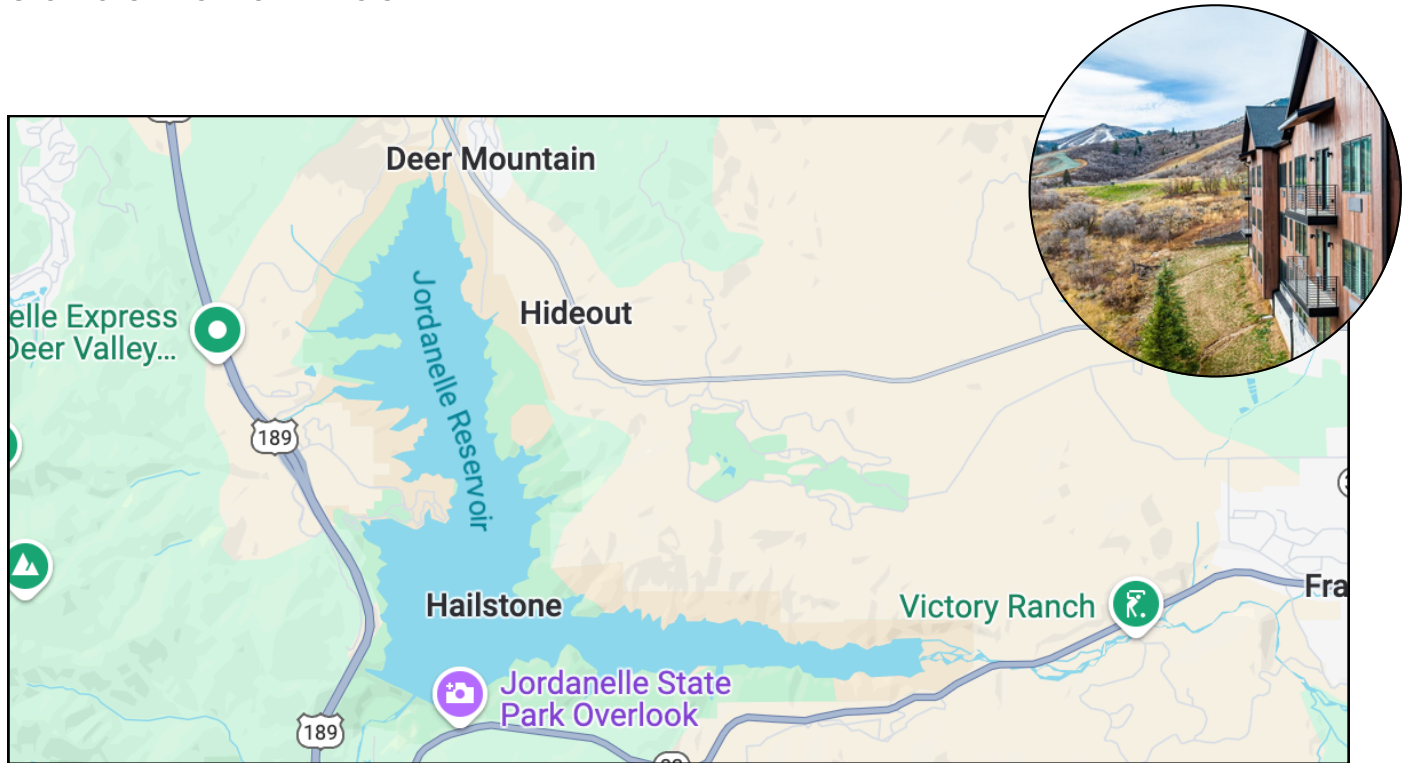
Welcome to the neighborhood: Snyderville Basin

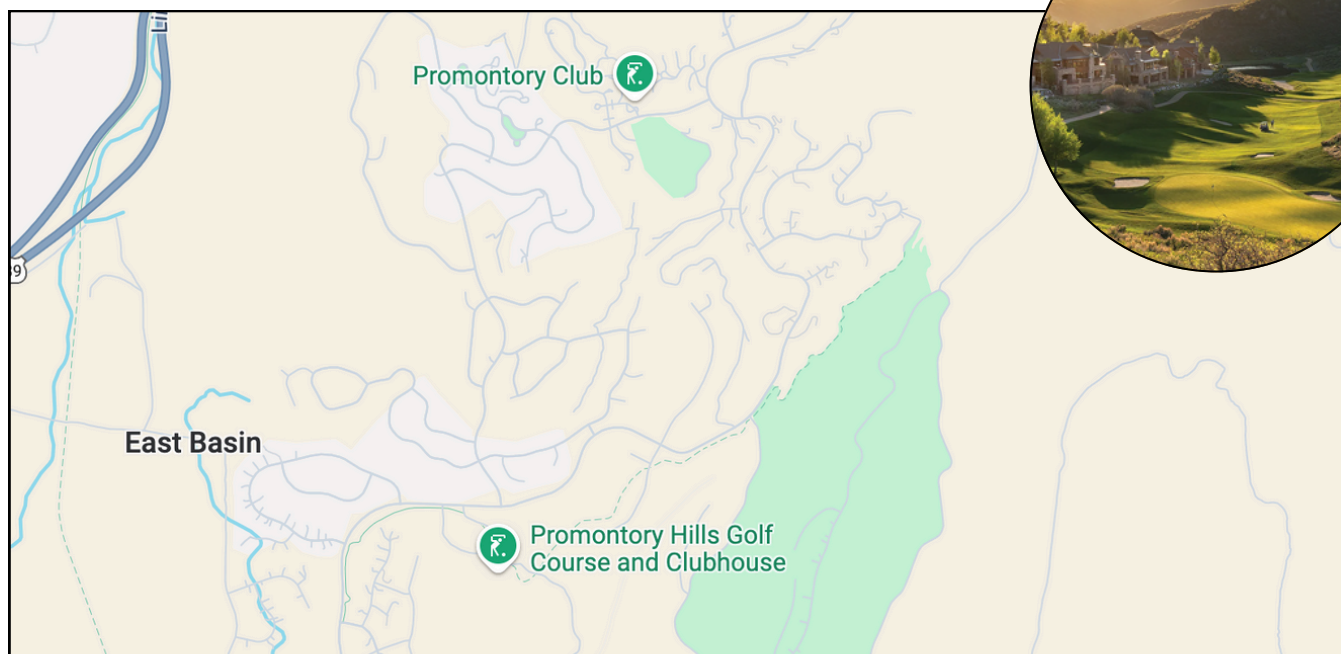
