



1201 King Street, Charleston, SC

Located under the I-26 overpass, this playground offers shaded play areas.
Restroom availability may vary; it's advisable to check current conditions before visiting.



155 Jackson Street, Charleston, SC

This park includes a playground, basketball courts, and the region's only public 50-meter pool. Restrooms are available to support various activities.



1 1443 Secessionville Road, Charleston, SC

Featuring a playground and open spaces, this park provides public restrooms during staffed hours, accommodating family needs.



780 West Oak Forest Drive, Charleston, SC

This neighborhood park offers a playground and baseball field. Restrooms are typically available during staffed hours.



1580 Ashley Gardens Blvd, Charleston, SC

This 25-acre park includes a playground, athletic fields, and nature trails. Restrooms are available, supporting a full day of family activities.



70 East Bay Street, Charleston, SC

Located in the historic district, this playground offers shaded areas and is one of the few with public restrooms south of Broad Street.



1 Concord Street, Charleston, SC

Situated near the South Carolina
Aquarium, this park features a nauticalthemed playground and public restrooms,
making it ideal for downtown visits.

This park boasts a playground, splash pad, and extensive trails. Accessible restrooms and water fountains are located at the Park Center and Picnic Center.
