INTERIOR:

GENERAL:

- □ Repair sheetrock or plaster cracks after verifying these are not caused by structural problems.
- Clean and/or repair walls. Choose light neutral colors. Paint ceilings a lighter shade of the wall color or white to emphasize height.
- □ If wallpaper is not custom, remove and paint neutral color. Adjoining rooms in neutral colors emphasize space.
- □ Clean carpeting or replace badly stained or worn carpet padding with neutral color.
- □ Replace if carpet was ever completely wet.
- □ Clean drapes and blinds. Clean all HVAC vents.
- Store excess furniture, luggage, sports gear, bicycles, and clothes.
- Eliminate clutter emphasize space in entry, hallways, closets, rooms, and garage.

BATH:

- □ Check caulking
- □ Clean or replace shower curtain
- □ Replace stained or broken tile
- □ Clean grout or regrout
- □ Repair any leaking faucets
- □ Re-glaze enamel in tub if stained
- □ Replace chipped commode seat.
- KITCHEN:
- $\hfill\square$ Replace broken or stained counter tile, grout
- Clean all appliances inside and out
- □ Clean microwave vent grill and cooktop hood

KITCHEN (Cont.):

- □ Replace sink if stained, chipped or dented
- Unclutter countertops, appliances, cabinets, etc.
- □ Check baseboard.
- □ Clean water heater.

LIVING AREAS:

- □ Check all light switches
- Replace bulbs and fixtures as necessary
- □ Remove unnecessary small rugs
- □ Wax Floors
- □ Remove collected magazines and newspapers
- □ Check baseboards and ceiling moldings
- □ Clean fireplace set logs or plants.
- ☐ If wallpaper is not custom, remove and paint neutral color. Adjoining rooms in neutral colors to emphasize space.

BEDROOMS:

- □ Make sure linens are clean
- Remove excess clothes, linens from closets so they appear larger
- □ Place solid deodorizers in closets.
- GARAGE/BASEMENT:
- □ Vacuum floors and shelves
- Organize storage to leave easy attic access and emphasize space
- □ Add lighting if needed.

DON'T FORGET TO:

□ Test all door and cabinet knobs.

EXTERIOR:

- □ Keep the lawn mowed and edged; replace dead grass.
- Shape shrubs and trim trees; remove any dead branches or insect webs.
- Pick up leaves and weed beds or planter boxes.
- If a pool is covered, remove any debris;
 if uncovered, vacuum, replace any broken
 coping; water must be clear.
- ☐ If you have planned for a winter sale, consider planting rye grass.
- Make sure the address is visible, either freshly painted or with new applied numerals.
- Replace any torn or loose screens; patch and paint any peeling or damaged window sills or trim; replace any broken window panes or insulated windows with condensation.
- Replace and paint any rotten wood; remove and repaint blistered or chipped paint.

- □ Clean gutters and downspouts; replace any that are cracked or bent.
- Remove any mildew; consider power washing the façade and/or walks.
- ☐ Fill any cracks in the drive and walks; remove any grease stains.
- Remove any pet droppings and fix any gnawed, scratched, or stained trim or flooring.
- □ Add seasonal flowers for color.
- ☐ Treat the exterior of the garage the same as the house.
- □ Repaint or re-stain the front door if needed and make sure the handle works.
- □ Clean all windows, inside and out.
