520 Park Avenue Could Be NYC's Newest Real Estate Status Symbol

It's being built by the same architects and developers as 15 Central Park West.

Robert A.M. Stern designed 15 Central Park West, one of the most buzzed-about buildings in New York City real estate history, and now the architect has set his sights across town, recently unveiling plans for a 54-story limestone tower at 520 Park Avenue.

Zeckendorf Development, which was also behind 15 CPW, is overseeing this new project where the average unit price will be \$38 million. Construction is expected to be completed by early 2018, at which point the tower will be the tallest building on Manhattan's Upper East Side. It'll include 23 full-floor simplex apartments, four simplex penthouses, five duplex penthouses (each approximately 9,100 square feet), and a triplex penthouse apartment with 12,400 square feet of interior space and 1,700 square feet of exterior space.
