


\$2.85M Soho Loft Mixes Historic Cast Iron Charm with Modern Industrial Design

This full-floor two-bedroom loft is located in the heart of SoHo's landmarked Cast Iron Historic District at 543 Broadway and is currently priced at \$2.85 million. The expansive unit is situated on a high floor of a Neo-Classical loft building and is accessed through a private, key-locked elevator. From stainless steel appliances and glass-framed rooms to vaulted ceilings and original exposed brick, this home has the perfect combination of architectural details and luxury amenities.





The extra-large living room and dining area has six windows that face the eastern skies; original oak hardwood floors and elegant modern lighting run throughout the unit. The kitchen is equipped with top-of-the-line stainless steel appliances, including wine storage, a gas range stove, a large pantry, and center island.



The unit also has a very unique office area that is separated from the other common spaces with window-framed steel walls. The master bedroom suite has a large walk-in closet and a huge en-suite bathroom decked out with gorgeous mosaic tiles, Waterworks finishes, a claw-foot soaking tub, and separate shower.
