Making Your Home Show-Ready:

Before EVERY Showing:

- □ Open all blinds and curtains
- \square Set thermostat to comfortable temperature
- □ Put away all personal items and clutter
- □ Clean kitchen sink and counters
- Make all beds
- □ Close toilet lids
- □ Remove trash
- Secure pets or remove them
- Play soft background music (optional)
- Leave the house during showings

Showing Etiquette:

DO: ✓ Be flexible with showing times ✓ Accept last-minute showing requests when possible ✓ Leave immediately when buyers arrive ✓ Let your realtor handle all communication ✓ Keep your home show-ready at all times ✓ Provide easy access (lockbox or flexible schedule)

DON'T: X Stay home during showings (buyers feel uncomfortable) X Follow buyers around or eavesdrop X Start conversations with buyers or their agents X Point out features or try to "sell" the home yourself X Take feedback personally X Refuse reasonable showing requests X Leave valuable items out (secure jewelry, medications, etc.)

Open House Strategy:

- Generates buzz and excitement
- Attracts neighbors who may know interested buyers
- Creates urgency and competition
- Good for first weekend on market
- Opportunity for mass showings

Preparation:

- Extra deep clean
- Stage perfectly
- Secure valuables and medications
- Put away personal documents
- Have your realtor present
- Provide marketing materials
