Executives from a cannabis firm, an education nonprofit, a car maker and a big investment bank were among the sellers of the priciest homes to change hands in metro Phoenix in mid-April.

\$6,295,000

The Zega Trust bought a 9,686-square-foot Paradise Valley mansion with six bedrooms and eight bathrooms. The house comes with a sweeping staircase, a foyer with a chandelier, a full bar, a movie theater, a hair salon, a library, a guest house and a sports court. Jeffrey Cardot, founder of the cannabis testing firm Onpoint Laboratories, was the seller. Christopher Karas of the brokerage Launch Powered By Compass had the listing.

\$6,100,000

Everett Reese II paid cash for a Paradise Valley home that wasn't listed for sale. Donald and Leslie Budinger sold it. Don is a founder of manufacturer Rodel Inc. and the nonprofit education group Rodel Foundation.

The Gina Young Trust paid cash for a 9,020-square-foot mansion in the north Scottsdale community Troon. The home, situated on 2.5 acres, has five bedrooms, seven bathrooms, a six-car garage, dual dishwashers, a large walk-in pantry, a wine room with a brick ceiling, two bathrooms in the primary suite and a guest house. Robert and Connie Bohn sold it. Robert is the former chairman and CEO of Oshkosh Corp., a Wisconsin-based specialty automotive manufacturer.

Amnon Salim paid cash for a 7,412-square-foot home with three bedrooms and five bathrooms in north Scottsdale's Desert Mountain community. Steven and Beverlynn Elliott were the sellers. Steven was the senior vice chairman of The Bank of New York Mellon Corp.

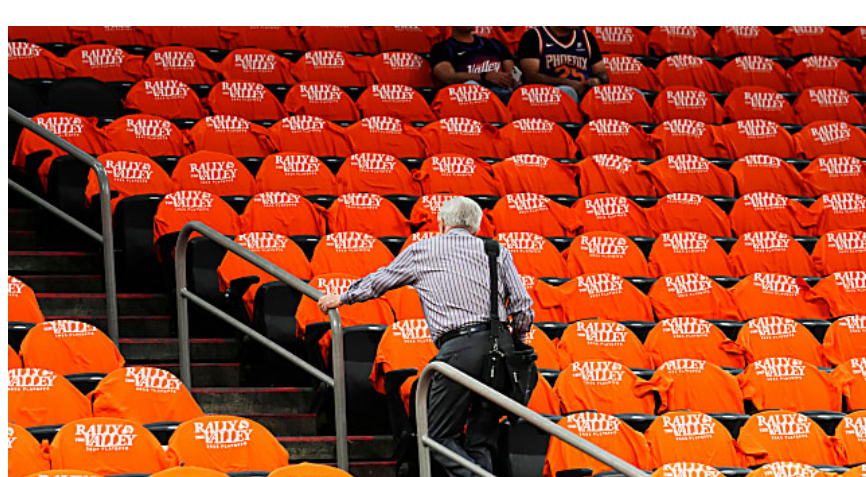
