15. It shall be the responsibility of the remover to adhere to all procedures as outlined in State of Connecticut Regulations - NFPA 30 & 327 - along with the regulations of any other state or federal agency. IF TANK IS LEAKING, NOTIFY D.E.P AT 566-3338.
