Approximately 9,400sqft, unparalleled scale with soaring 40ft ceilings in the main great room, glamorous sunken conversation pit surrounding a monumental wood-burning fireplace. Water, steel, stone and glass combine to create a sensory experience like no other. Wrapped by a swimming pool inspired by a personal lake, the indoors blend seamlessly outside. Current building codes would not allow such a large pool and many other incredible elements. Complete privacy and security in prestigious celebrity enclave.
