



From the mature hardwood forests and four natural ponds to the custom-built brick residence and fully equipped equestrian facility, every acre tells a story of stewardship, vision and enduring purpose. A second private building site overlooking one of the ponds adds an additional layer of thoughtful potential to this once-in-a-generation offering. This extraordinary property is not just a residence but a long-term legacy, safeguarding vital ecosystems, rare plant species and thriving wildlife habitat for generations to come.

The estate's protected acreage includes over 200 acres of mature hardwood forest, home to native wildlife and the ecologically significant Palestine Rare Plants. These lands are permanently conserved and shielded from development, offering a sense of enduring purpose and environmental integrity. For the conservation-focused buyer, this represents an unmatched opportunity to live among and protect North Carolina's natural beauty while enjoying the privacy and possibilities of expansive land ownership.

Complementing the forest canopy are 13 fenced acres of rich, open pasture ideal for equestrian pursuits and 30 acres of active hay fields, each seasonally productive and visually commanding. The property also features four naturally formed ponds that support healthy aquatic ecosystems and offer peaceful retreats throughout the property. A thoughtfully maintained trail system connects these distinct zones, offering miles of hiking, horseback riding and wildlife observation.

Anchoring the estate is a stately full-brick, custom-built residence. A one-owner home, purposefully sited to overlook serene pastures and tree-lined horizons has been meticulously maintained. Built with enduring materials and pride of place, the residence blends timeless architecture with the seclusion and tranquility of its surroundings, providing both comfort and connection to the land. A second, private building envelope is located in a secluded clearing overlooking one of the tranquil ponds. Ideal for constructing a guesthouse, artist studio or private retreat, this secondary site offers flexibility for multi-generational living or bespoke personal use while remaining compliant with the land's conservation easement.

Equestrians and hobby farmers will appreciate the well-equipped infrastructure, including a 3-to 5-stall horse barn and a professionally sized 100-by-250-foot arena. Several outbuildings and workshop spaces offer ample storage for equipment, tools and vehicles, supporting agricultural or recreational uses with ease.

Despite its size and private setting, the estate is located just a short drive from essential amenities, including the city of Albemarle, a local airport, the charming Badin town center, Morrow Mountain State Park and the recreational waters of Badin Lake. This rare position offers both connection and retreat — perfect for those seeking a peaceful, purposeful lifestyle without sacrificing accessibility.

While traditional financing for land of this size may be limited, the property's unique conservation value and scale are expected to attract discerning cash buyers looking to leave a mark of positive environmental impact, equestrian excellence, or multi-generational retreat.







Badin, NC, is a historic company town recognized on the National Register of Historic Places. This French flavored village at the foot of the Uwharrie Mountains offers a pleasant pause in a quaint setting. The town was developed by the Southern Aluminum Company (later Alcoa) in the early 20th century. It's characterized by its unique French-inspired architecture and rich industrial history, with many buildings reflecting the town's aluminum smelting past. The downtown area features the Badin Historic District, a collection of contributing buildings including residential, commercial, and institutional structures.

Morrow Mountain State Park. Located in Stanly County, Morrow Mountain State Park provides a myriad of adventures from the summit of the namesake mountain, along the banks of the Yadkin River State Trail, and to the shores of Lake Tillery. The mountain is a study in geologic wonder — with Native American artifacts made of rhyodacite to argillite mined by the Civilian Conservation Corps to create many of the park's structures.



Badin Lake is one of a series of lakes created by the damming of the Yadkin-Pee Dee River in the Uwharrie Lakes Region of the United States. The Badin Lake Dam was built in 1917 to support local aluminum smelting plant, Alcoa, and the



Lake Tillery is a reservoir in the Uwharrie Lakes Region of North Carolina. The lake was created by impounding the Pee Dee River, which is created by the confluence of the Yadkin River and the Uwharrie River several miles to the north.

Uwharrie National Forest. With more than 50,000 acres and nearly 80 square miles of territory, the Uwharrie National Forest is a treasure trove full of beautiful scenery, wildlife and trails for all sorts of activities. There is ample room for horseback riding, hiking, trail running, mountain biking, hunting, camping, dedicated trails for off-road vehicles and more.



The Uwharrie Mountains, according to legend, gained their name from the name of an Indian tribe indigenous to the area. These thickly wooded, low-lying ridges are considered the
