WHAT YOU'LL LOVE


Endless peaceful walks or jogs, where neighbors stop and say hello to everyone. Many local coffee shops, boutiques and fine dining galore!

Where is Oak Bay?



The entire South Island is within easy reach, and the mainland just a quick hop away.

Oak Bay is just under 4 km from downtown Victoria, a short 11 minute dash.

From Oak Bay, the BC Ferries Swartz Bay Terminal is 34KM away.

Oak Bay is an easy commute to the DND dockyard, CFB Esquimalt, at just under 9 km.




UVic, the oldest university in BC, is a quick 4.6 km from Oak Bay. You will find a vibrant student community of all ages.
