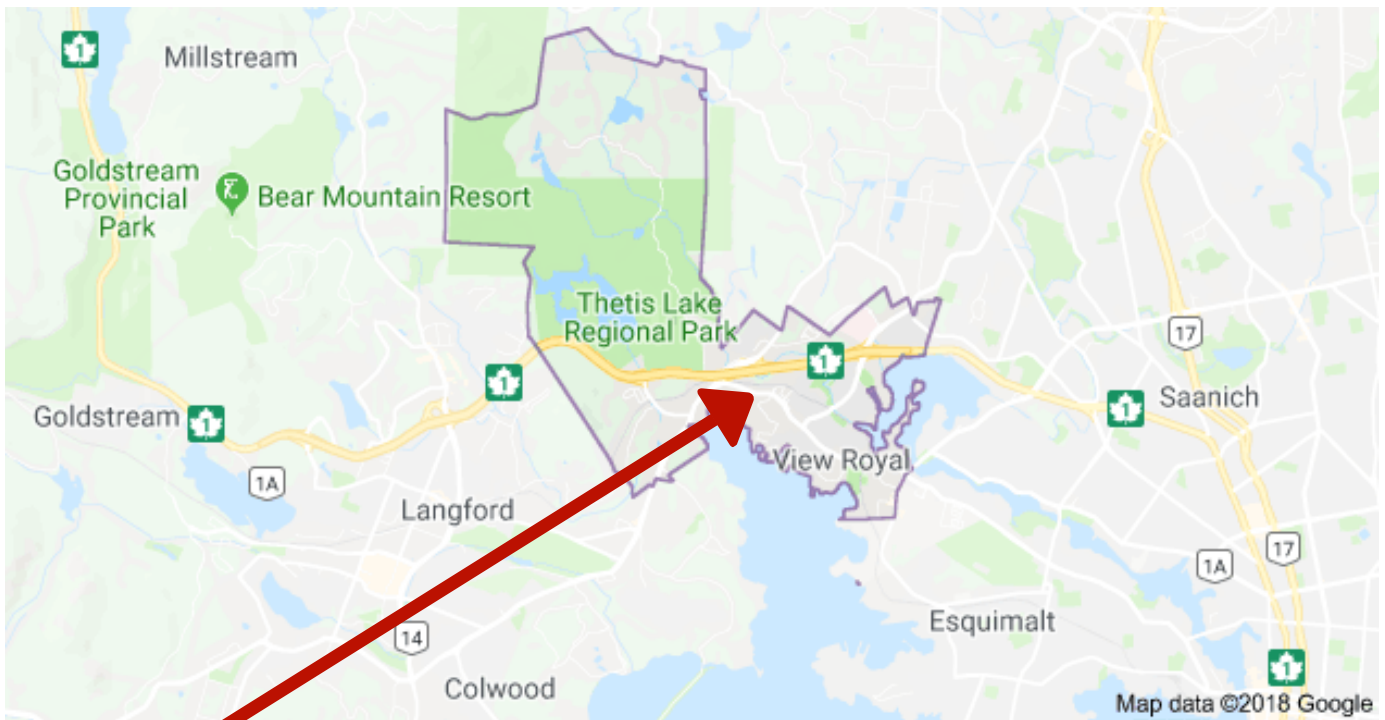

UVic, the oldest university in BC, is a quick 20KM from View Royal where you will find a vibrant student community of all ages.

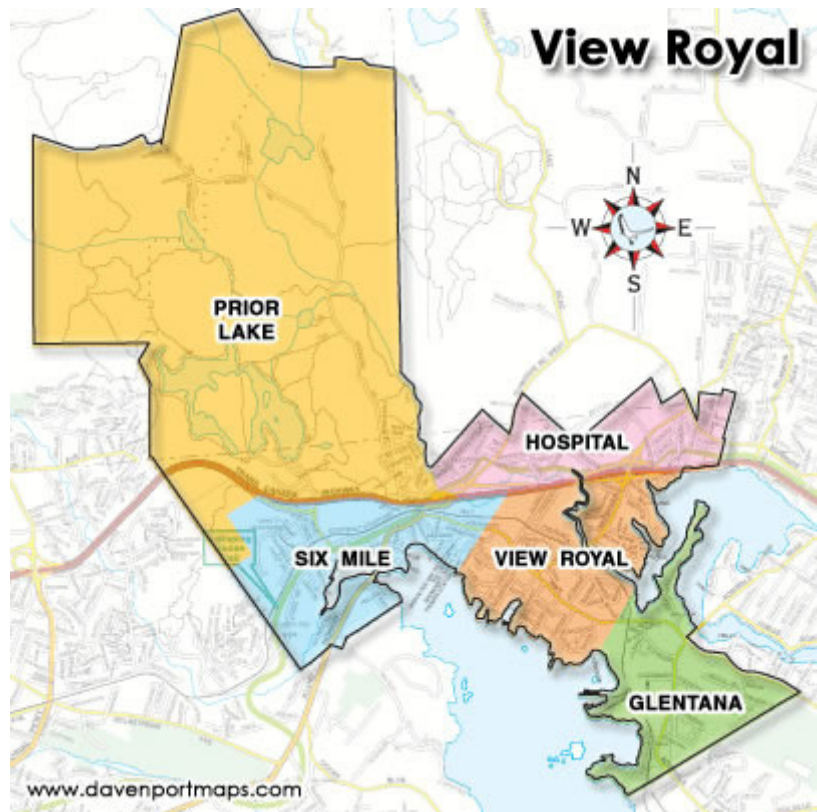
# The View Royal Neighbourhood
