Align Community Involvement Recap 2025

This year, Align raised \$11,395 to support and uplift the most vulnerable members of our community.

Monetary Donations

We contributed \$12,855.97 to 16 nonprofits and community causes, including Utah Food Bank, Utah Disabled American Veterans, Sageland Collaborative, Granite Education Foundation, 4th Street Clinic, International Rescue Committee, Downtown Alliance Fire Fund, First Step House, The Road Home, Granite CEO Program, YWCA, Utah Pride Center, Best Friends Animal Society, and local classroom support for exceptional teachers.

Supply Donations

In addition to our monetary donations, we donated \$4,575 in supplies to various charities. These contributions included lunch supplies for The Road Home Family Center to provide meals for preschool children, Santa Sacks for Granite Education Foundation, and books and socks for our annual drives.


Volunteer Hours

Drives & Fundraisers

Align hosted three drives this year: 1) a blood drive with the American Red Cross, 2) our annual book drive supporting the Granite School District, where 47% of students lack adequate access to books, and 3) our annual Socktober sock drive, where we collected over 1,000 pairs of socks for children in need.

The mission of The Road Home is to help people step out of homelessness and back into our community. The Road Home is a private nonprofit social services agency that assists individuals and families experiencing homelessness in Salt Lake County and along the Wasatch Front.
