Attachment B Services and Associated Fees

Full Care Boarding \$500/month

- Pasture & Stall access as determined by Manager - note pastures are routinely rested/rotated
- Access to amenities - such as equestrian complex, covered & open riding arenas, wash rack, trails, ect.
- Feed provided - 12/6 grain equivalent or ration balancer 1x or 2x daily -based on horse needs
- Hay provided - coastal round bale in pasture and supplementary hay/alfalfa as determined by Manager
- Care - regularly check horse for ailments and provide fly spray
- Handling - Catching horses from pasture for farrier and medical needs
- Transport - trailering horses from larger turnout pastures to barn location for use
- Scheduling - any farrier and routine medical care
- Storage - available for saddle, tack and supplies
- Blanketing in winter weather conditions - as determined between owner & manager
- Administering topical or oral medications - case by case basis
- Administering feed supplements or special feed preparations

Self Care Boarding \$150/month

- Pasture access as determined by Manager - note pastures are routinely rested/rotated
- Access to amenities - such as equestrian complex, covered & open riding arenas, wash rack, trails, ect.
- Storage for feed, equipment and tack storage access **determined by Manager**
- Owner is responsible for ALL care of horse including: supplying feed & hay, checking waterers, blanketing, monitoring horse health, ect. Owner is responsible for scheduling feed or hay delivery, farrier services and medical needs

(Additional a la carte services may be agreed and specified below between Boarder and Stab

Additional A La Carte Services For Self Care Boarding (charges determined on specifics of service)

- Feeding while out of town 1x daily (additional charge for 2x/day or specialized feeding) \$20/day/horse***
- Turnout Blanketing - due to clipping or show condition by owner preference/ or weather \$100/month or \$10/horse per request
- Blanket cleaning \$50/per blanket
- Handling during veterinarian or farrier service \$25 hourly
- Parasite Control (De-worming/Testing) year-round \$100/yr
- Administering topical or oral medications, per day - case by case basis \$ check with staff
- Administering feed supplements or special feed preparations - case by case basis \$ check with staff
- Exercising of horses \$50 hourly

*In severe drought conditions, a surcharge for food and hay may be added following 30 day notification to Boarder

** Preservation of pasture may warrant the Stable, with thirty day notice to Boarder, to place roll bale of hay at pasture/paddock at the expense of the Boarder.

*** Cap rate of \$60/day on out of town feeding for owners with more than 3 horses
