
The City of Collevville is being proactive about supporting our local businesses by rolling out some







Hail is one of the most common and costly weather hazards in the United States, causing hundreds of millions of dollars in damage to buildings, vehicles and crops every year. Help guard against the damaging effect of this severe weather event by following the hailstorm safety steps below.

Make a plan: A hailstorm can disrupt electrical service and is often accompanied by other severe weather events, such as hurricanes and tornadoes. Prepare your family for the hazards and inconveniences of a hailstorm by creating a disaster preparedness plan, including a disaster survival kit and an emergency evacuation plan.

Stay informed: Hail often occurs during severe weather patterns, such as strong thunderstorms. When severe weather threatens, tune in to weather reports for updates. A severe thunderstorm watch means that a storm poses an immediate threat to the people and property in its path. This warning may be accompanied by a siren or other community alert system.

Move inside, stay inside: Hailstones vary greatly in size, but even small ones — driven by gravity and strong winds — pose a danger to anything or anyone caught in a storm. As a storm approaches, put vehicles in the garage and bring pets inside. Once you're indoors, close all drapes, blinds or shades to prevent broken window glass and hailstones from entering your home. If possible, move to any other level of the building not directly below the roof.

If you're on the road during a hailstorm, stay in your vehicle and slow down or stop, as roads may become slippery. Once you have pulled over safely, turn your back to windows or cover yourself with a blanket to protect yourself from broken glass.

Protect your roof: Roof damage is a common consequence of hailstorms. Following a strong storm, you should evaluate the condition of your roof to identify any damage and prevent further deterioration. The Federal Alliance of Safe Homes (FLASH) has information about strengthening your home's roof decking and shingles against hail and other severe weather. Even if your roof is not currently damaged, you may want to discuss making these changes with a reputable roofing contractor.

Roofing Discounts: You may qualify for discounts on your homeowner's insurance premiums if you use certain impact-resistant roofing products. Premium reductions are not available for roofs that have been overlaid onto existing roofs, except for certain qualifying metal roofs. Read this list of qualifying roofing products and the states where discounts are available.

I recently traveled to Cuba and can't wait to go back! Tourist travel to Cuba is prohibited by the US government for US citizens, however, you may visit Cuba if your travel falls under one of the 12 authorized categories – my Food and Drink tour was a "people to people" educational travel and cultural exchange and so was allowed. We flew to Havana from Miami on a commercial American Airlines flight.

One memorable dinner was at the San Cristobal Paladar (a Paladar is a privately owned and operated restaurant) and was spectacular. The Obamas dined there in 2016 and other notable guests have included the Kardashians and Beyonce. The food scene in Cuba is still in its infancy, so lots of experimentation is happening. In general, entrees were simple and usually didn't

have a sauce or fancy sides. Seafood was everywhere (swordfish, ceviche, lobster), as well as rice and beans, and everything you can think of was made from taro root or guava.

The national drinks of Cuba all start with rum and include The Mojito, The Daiquiri and The Cuba Libre. I was surprised to find out that the "mint" in a Mojito was not Spearmint as I had originally thought, but a similar relative called "Hierbabuena," which is less minty and more citrus-y. I hope to find some and grow it this summer here in Texas!

Art and music are everywhere in Havana. There are many galleries, but also sculptures, tiled murals and even graffiti that caught my eye. "La Habana Vieja," or Old Town, is a UNESCO World

The GC High School Hockey Club is excited about being featured in Colleyville Charm Magazine. Opportunities like this don't happen often for HS hockey clubs because in Texas, HS Hockey is not UIL sanctioned. This means teams don't get support from the school system -- financial or otherwise.

Despite the lack of support, the sport is in its 22nd year and the number of participants is growing. The Dallas Stars manage HS hockey in the state much like UIL does for sports they support. This season there are more than 60 teams and over 1,000 players in the state.

While this sounds substantial, 60 teams is a small fraction of the number of senior and junior high schools. There are very few schools in the state that have enough players for a hockey team, therefore, most teams are comprised of players from multiple schools.

The GC varsity team has 19 players from seven schools (GHS, CHHS, LD Bell, Trinity, Birdville, Arlington Heights and Benbrook). Twelve of the 19 players are from GCISD and five of them are graduating seniors. Brad Branscum from GHS will attend University of Arkansas, Alec Monhollen from Collegiate Academy will attend Texas A&M, Damon Davanloo from CHHS will attend UNT. Thomas Demers and Mason Goddard from CHHS are undecided on colleges.

The GC Club consists of a Varsity and a JV team. The JV team finished fifth place of 10 teams with an 8-8 record. The Varsity team finished second place of nine teams with a 15-3 record. The Varsity team is heading to the State Tournament March 16-19 where it hopes to win its fourth State Championship. Check out the team website at grapevinehockey.com.








SENIOR PHOTOS?

Annette Walters is a Colleyville mom of a Senior at Covenant Christian, a veteran ReloMom, Realtor, now an aspiring photographer of one CCA Senior and lives in the Alliane Neighborhood.

Last month I took a photography class I found on Colleyville Moms Facebook Page. It was about learning how to use all those manual features my fancy camera has. It was fantastic! FStop, aperture, white balance and focus all make more sense.

Armed and dangerous, I've decided to tackle my Son's Senior Portraits, hopefully, without too much eye rolling. But Where???

My "Senior Guy Photos" Pinterest board show forests, pastures, fences, bridges and brick walls. I don't want to extend my son's painful photo experience any longer than I have to. I need to find these areas close by and on the **Cheap!** 

Focusing on public property to accomplish the cheap goal, I toured local parks and public buildings. I found everything I was looking for in three places: The Webb House with Red Caboose, Parr Park and McPherson Park.

The Webb House with Red Caboose has that olde tyme feel. With a beautifully restored prairie farmhouse and garden, bright Red caboose and grand wildflowers, now in bloom, this gave us multiple areas to take vibrant pictures. For natural framing, choose the Caboose or front porch. Let them hang offer the edges or lean in their most comfortable position. Next, go explore Parr Park, in Grapevine. Parr Par has wide open fields full of green and large, wide trees perfect for those fuzzy background pictures. Imagine these trees in full green with a bright blue sky. Parr Park also has two beautiful bridges. The lines of the bridges are very popular and pull the eye toward your subjects. By choosing to include plaque, you will always know where the photos were taken.

And, finally, McPherson Park has industrial, historical and vintage elements. These elements give nice contrast to your dancers and context to your outdoorsy FFA students or Scouts. The barn doors, corrugated steel and red clay log cabin provide structured framing of your photos while the great greenery and a fountain provide a natural and flowing setting.

Other exceptional photo spots include the water fountains around Colleyville City Park and Bear Creek Park off 360

in Grapevine which has a large Bridge and more natural wooded background.

**Watch** the light. All times of day do not work for photography. Before you get the kids dressed and out the door to investigate what kind of light you like. Parr Park was taken at dusk with a haze. McPherson was taken midday. The Webb house & Caboose has great morning and evening sun. My preference is early morning sun.

It's time to get the camera out and explore.


