Recent Improvements and Upgrades

The property has benefitted from several hundred thousands of dollars in improvements and upgrades over the past few years which include:

Heating and Cooling

- 2 new Napolean furnaces (forced air with return)
- 2 new Napoleon air conditioning units
- New 20kw Generac generator
- New Ecobee smart home temperature control system
- New propane tank (1000 gallon) with BBQ hook-up

Plumbing

- New UV system with carbon filter and seven filter drinking water station
- New iron and sulphur filtration system
- New water softener
- New hot tub heater and pump with newly installed direct access to the plumbing for easy fill up year round
- \$40,000+ Italian Steam Shower

Security and Technology

- New hard wired, web accessible, four camera security system
- New Starlink internet

Exterior - Building, Side Yard, Rooftop, and Entrance

- Entire roof replaced within the past 6-7 years.
- The entire cottage/home including all the decks are in the process of being freshly painted/stained (will be completed before closing)
- New composite deck with aluminum railings with gates around the deck and side yard.
- New firepit in the side yard and new propane fire pit on the rooftop deck.
- The steps at the entrance have been recently repaired/improved with solid granite ledges on each step

Exterior – Lakefront

- New 24' x 16' poly/composite NY Dock with kayak rack and 8' bridge (dock can be left in the water year-round)
- New clear glass railings at lakeside deck.
- New swim raft with ladder
- New oscillating aquatic weed fan (keeps the water weed free for 30 feet in all directions

Interior

- Most of the kitchen appliances are new or newer. Some in the second kitchen have almost never been used.
- New washing machine.
- New Hunter Douglas blackout blinds in all rooms
- Plexiglass recently installed to the back bedroom on the top floor that was previously open to below to add privacy and drown out noise
- Recently changed the placement of the doors on the upper level to make the primary bedroom separate/private from the in-law suite.

 in-law suite, 3 fireplaces (one wood burning, one propane, and one electric) and rooftop
 deck with hot tub and gorgeous lake views.
- Extremely private location
 - o Last property on the road and the only property on the east side of the bay
 - 1000+ acres of crown land provincial park adjacent too and in behind the property and thousands of feet of undeveloped crown land provincial park shoreline to one side
 - With no mainland access to the mainland portion of the provincial park this land is only used by a few people on the road and includes many hiking trails for you to enjoy almost completely to yourself.
- Conveniently located only a 10 minute drive from Buckhorn, 30 minutes from both Lakefield and Bobcaygeon, 40 minutes from Peterborough and 2 hours from downtown Toronto.
- Located on the shores of highly sought after Lower Buckhorn Lake which is part of the historic Trent-System Waterway providing unlimited boating opportunities throughout the system. By boat you can visit several towns, and several on-lake restaurants and marinas (some accessed through locks)
- Western exposure, providing good all-day sun right up until sunset and spectacular sunsets.
