Parks & Recreation







Union City offers miles of recreational space, highlighted by Dry Creek Regional Park with extensive hiking trails through natural California landscapes for exercise and relaxation.

The city features numerous sports fields, tennis and basketball courts and community centers with year-round programs for all ages, including youth sports leagues and senior fitness classes. Other parks include Kennedy Park with large lawns and playgrounds for families, Contempo Park with art installations and community events and Quarry Lakes Regional Recreation Area for swimming and fishing.

Union City's Recreation Department runs diverse programs such as youth leagues for baseball, soccer and basketball, along with swimming lessons, summer camps, adult fitness, tennis and senior activities at community centers.

Kennedy Youth Center

Offers aerobics, yoga, Zumba, basketball, volleyball and a full weight and cardio room for all ages.
