Step 2: Declutter Your Home












- You want to maximize profits on the sale of your home.








- Carpet replacement or cleaning







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
Pre-Staging Checklist



	LIGHTING ☐ Ensure that all light bulbs work. Replace any burned out bulbs. *Tip: When you have exposed light bulbs, we recommend buying Edison light bulbs.
	 KITCHEN □ Remove all non-decorative items from counters (dish soap, paper towels, phones, cleaning supplies, etc) □ Remove magnets, photos, kids artwork, etc. from the refrigerator.
	FURNITURE ☐ Remove furniture that was previously discussed in your Redesign Consultation
	BATHROOM Remove toiletries from bath/shower area Clear countertops of non-decorative items Lower all toilet seats Empty all trash
	WINDOW TREATMENTS Open curtains/blinds all the way in every room *Tip: Pull up all blinds - professional pictures will look sharper
*** ****	HOLIDAY DECOR Remove all holiday decor. Examples: pumpkins, Christmas trees/ights, menorahs, wreaths, etc.
	FRONT & BACKYARD ☐ Take down flags ☐ Put hoses and other equipment away, organize patio deck ☐ Pick up pet waste, put away garbage bins, and generally clean up yard ☐ Freshly-cut lawn and have landscaping in good shape
	CLEANING ☐ Generally make the house as clean as possible (Remove streaks from mirrors, sweep/mop floors, vacuum, make bets, etc.) ☐ Please do not smoke in the home while your house is listed. This is important for your potential buyers not to be put off by the smoke.
000	OTHER Remove any religious symbols from view Turn ceiling fans off Take out all trash Put all personal items away










	LIGHTING ☐ Turn on all interior and exterior lights Including floor lamps, table lamps, under-cabinet lighting, stove-top lighting, etc.
	 KITCHEN □ Remove all non-decorative items from counters (dish soap, paper towels, phones, cleaning supplies, etc) □ Remove magnets, photos, kids artwork, etc. from the refrigerator.
	VEHICLES ☐ Ensure that no vehicles are in the driveway or on the street in front of the home ☐ Close garage doors
· •	BATHROOM Remove toiletries from bath/shower area Clear countertops of non-decorative items Lower all toilet seats Empty all trash
	WINDOW TREATMENTS Open curtains/blinds all the way in every room
	HOLIDAY DECOR Remove all holiday decor. Examples: pumpkins, Christmas trees/ights, menorahs, wreaths, etc.
	PETS ☐ keep all pets off the premises or at minimum, confined to the best of your ability ☐ Put away all pet supplies ☐ Including food/water, crates, toys, towers, etc.

How To Care For Staging Items

Take photos of made beds. This is to ensure that you can replicate the placement of the bedspreads and pillows for the showing.

Please do not sleep on staged bedspreads and pillows. This is to ensure that the beds will look crisp, clean, and wrinkle free for showings.

Keep all pets off of the staged furniture, rugs, bedspreads pillows etc....

Please inform us of any broken or stained items. We take pictures and video inventory when we leave to ensure that we take back only our items.

Please do not use staging towels and bath mats. They are there to ensure a clean look for showings.

Please do not smoke in the home while your house is listed. This is important for your potential buyers not to be put off by the smoke.

When using our furniture please place a blanket or towel down to not stain or soil items. Then remove blanket and towel for showings.

Please do not drink the provided beverages. They are for showing only.

After your home is sold and is out of attorney's review, we will schedule a pick up for our staged items. Please have as many items as you are capable of moving gathered at your front door.

Once staging items have been picked up - all personal items in the home, garage, basement, and yard should be removed and broom-clean unless previously arranged through attorneys. That includes all paint, shelving units, swing-sets, garbage, trampolines...

RECOMMENDED TO BE COMPLETED ONCE PER WEEK

	Run all faucets
	Flush all toilets
	Run dishwasher and washer
	Pick up mail
	Pick up debris around house
	Take out all trash
	Assure that you have toilet paper, soap and hand towels in guest bathrooms
	Make sure all blow up mattresses are still inflated
	Check for burned out light bulbs
	Check basement and refrigerator for leaks
	Make sure electricity, water, and heat/air conditioning are all on
	All pipes on exterior walls need to have a trickle of water running through them at all times
	All surfaces should be dusted or swept as needed
	Remove dead bugs from all surfaces
	Make sure front door is presentable
	Outdoor lawn and plants should be maintained
П	Snow removal of driveway and walk-way as needed

Non-Staging Checklist



OUR RECOMMENDATIONS

Limit the amount of furniture in each room. We want to promote a spacious feel.
Take down soft curtains and vertical blinds
Replace old out of date bathroom fixtures and lighting fixtures
Remove all toiletries from counters, show and bath in all bathrooms
Bathroom decor - white towels, white mats or rugs, white shower curtain
Very limited decor - counters, walls, furniture, built-in bookcases, china cabinets, desks
Bedding should be solid color. White for master. Pink for girls room, Navy blue for boys room. Light gray for teen or guest room.
Remove all family pictures, religious decor, sport decor, political decor, and holiday decor
All rooms and closets should be tidy and well organized. Closets should be at 50% capacity. Pack all nonessential clothes, shoes and accessories
Kitchen - no dishes in sink, limited decor on counter, remove small appliances, remove all dish towels
