





Welcome to Skokie

About Skokie

The Village of Skokie, Illinois, located 16 miles northwest of downtown Chicago and 12 miles east of O'Hare International Airport, provides high-quality government services to the over 64,000 residents, 24,000 households and 2,400 businesses that call Skokie their home. Accessibility to transportation is a key advantage in Skokie, with the Edens Expressway (I-94) spanning the community's western edge, seven Chicago Transit Authority and 10 Pace suburban bus lines and the CTA's Skokie Swift rail line offering numerous options for public transportation.

Skokie covers 10 square miles of land and is bordered by the Villages of Glenview and Wilmette on the north, the Village of Lincolnwood and the City of Chicago (West Rogers Park and Edgebrook neighborhoods) on the south, the Villages of Morton Grove and Niles on the west and the City of Evanston on the east. Weekly refuse collection, a highly engineered Storm-Water Runoff Control System and sidewalk snow plowing are some of the many unique Village programs that enhance Skokie residents' quality of life. Superior municipal services together with the nationally acclaimed Skokie Park District, superb Skokie Public Library, and preeminent North Shore Center for the Performing Arts in Skokie, exceptional Skokie Northshore Sculpture Park and outstanding school districts make Skokie an excellent place to live. The Village is a recipient of a Governor's Hometown Award and has received "All America City" finalist distinction from the National Civic League.

The Village of Skokie was given a AAA bond rating from Fitch IBCA for its 2003 General Obligation bond series. In 2003 Money magazine named Skokie among the 80 fastest-growing suburbs in the entire nation. Chicago magazine continues to rank Skokie near the top in its suburban livability rating, praising the Village's schools, parks, municipal services and entertainment options.

Skokie was the first community in the entire United States to have nationally accredited Fire, Police and Public Works Departments. The Skokie Police Department is nationally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA), a credential it has held since 1988. The Skokie Fire Department holds both a Class 1 rating from the Insurance Services Office (ISO), an independent organization used by the insurance industry to rate fire fighting capability, and full accreditation from the Commission on Fire Accreditation International. In 2003 the Public Works Department achieved accreditation from the American Public Works Association, giving Skokie its status as the first town in the country to achieve this level of professional accreditation. In addition, the Skokie Health Department is only one of eight state-certified municipal health departments in Illinois and provides a wide range of services to Skokie residents.

The Village Board is committed to providing superior municipal services while holding the line on property taxes. In 1991, the Village Board committed to freeze municipal property taxes while expanding and enhancing government services. The municipal property tax freeze remains in effect today. The Village of Skokie also has some of the lowest user fees, such as those for vehicle registration, in the suburban Chicago area.

Quality government services work in tandem with the Village Board's focus on economic development. In recent years, the Village of Skokie has encouraged redevelopment in Downtown Skokie that now includes development of the Illinois Science + Technology Park on the 23.4-acre former Searle/Pfizer site. The Village also participated in an expansion and renovation of Westfield Old Orchard, developed the North Shore Center for the Performing Arts in Skokie, renovated the Southeast Industrial area and began improvements to the West Dempster Street corridor. Skokie is a founding member of the Chicago's North Shore Convention & Visitors Bureau that encourages visitors to contribute to the local economy. Each of these successful programs enhances the Village of Skokie's commercial tax base while adding new dimensions to its already abundant cultural offerings.

Evanston Golf Club

Evanston is an exciting 18 hole regulation course located at the Evanston Golf Club facility in Skokie, IL. From the longest tees it presents 6,593 yards of golf for a par of 70. The course was designed by Donald J. Ross, ASGCA and opened in 1917.



Weber Park Golf Course

Weber Park is a fun 9 hole par 3 course located at the Weber Park Golf Course facility in Skokie, IL. From the longest tees it features 1,095 yards of golf for a par of 27. The course was designed by Ken Killian, ASGCA/Richard P. Nugent, ASGCA and opened in 1973.

The course rating is 35.5 with a slope rating of 113. The course contact is Richard Lee, Golf Operations Manager.



Transportation

Accessibility to transportation is a key advantage for Skokie residents. The Edens Expressway (I-94) spans Skokie's western edge, while Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) and PACE suburban bus lines and the CTA's Skokie Swift Yellow rail line offer numerous options for public transportation.

Skokie Swift

The Skokie Swift - Yellow Line - is part of the CTA's rapid transit system. The route runs from Dempster Street in Skokie to the Howard Street Terminal in Chicago with one stop at Oakton Street in Downtown Skokie. At Howard Street, Yellow Line passengers can transfer to the Purple or Red Lines of the CTA. Service is provided daily, about every 10-12 minutes.

Skokie Swift - Dempster Station Parking

*No parking is available at the Oakton-Skokie Station. Those wishing to park should do so at the Dempster Street Station.

Effective May 1, 2014, to simplify the payment process for commuters at the Dempster-Skokie CTA Station, new digital payment terminals will be installed to replace the current token payment system for parking. The new payment terminals will be located inside the train station and will accept coins, paper bills and credit/debit card payments.

- **Skokie Swift South Lot** is adjacent to the Skokie Swift Station. The fee is \$3 per day payable at the Station. Payment can be made with cash, credit or debit cards.
- **Skokie Swift North Lot** is across Dempster Street north of the Skokie Swift Station. The fee is \$2 per day payable at the Swift Station. Payment can be made with cash, credit or debit cards. A limited number of spaces are available for a monthly permit fee of \$40 and applications are required.

Cubs Game-Day Parking at the Skokie Swift

The CTA Skokie Swift Yellow Line provides a convenient and inexpensive alternative to travel to Chicago Cubs baseball games. Two large parking lots at the Dempster Street Station provide easy parking, while the Yellow Line allows for direct access to the stadium.

The Dempster Street Station, located at 5001 Dempster Street, Skokie, Illinois 60077, has two parking lots. Dempster Street has a full interchange with I-94/Edens Expressway and the CTA Swift Station/parking is less than a half mile to the east. The South Lot is adjacent to the Skokie Swift Station, while the North Lot is across Dempster Street, north of the Skokie Swift Station. The fee is \$4 per day for the South Lot and \$2 per day for the North Lot.

Once parked, take the Skokie Swift Yellow Line to the Howard Street Station where you will transfer to the Red Line. Take the Red Line to the Addison Street stop. This station is a half block from the stadium. **Or** during rush hour, you may transfer from the Yellow Line to the Purple Line Express headed to the Loop and get off at the Red/Purple Line Sheridan stop.
