Home Showcase: Amenities distinguish South End condo





With fewer high-end listings to choose from in 2024, a propensity for immediate gratification and a general aversion to renovations, it makes sense that buyers are even more likely to seek out a property they can enjoy right away.

In the South End, that looks a lot like the Residences at 566, right on Columbus Avenue at the foot of the Back Bay and near, well, just about everything Boston. Unit 404, a two-bedroom condominium with dedicated garage space in the new

development, features its own private bells and whistles plus access to an eye-popping list of amenities that goes far beyond the fitness center and concierge service that have become ubiquitous.
