Statistics compiled for single family homes in Rhode Island, comparing December 2018 to December 2019.

Mott & Chace Sotheby's International Realty is pleased to release the Rhode Island real estate single family home statistics for December 2019. The median asking price for new listings increased 9.2%, while the median home price of sold listings increased 8.1%. The supply of inventory decreased from 6.0 months to 2.1 months when compared to the same time period last year. Additionally, the average days on market decreased 3.6% in December 2019 when compared to last year.

Single family home sales in December continued to experience a slight price appreciation, in part due to low inventory levels. The number of units for sale has decreased over the past year, indicating that the market may still be favoring sellers. Well-priced homes continue to be in demand.

The median price of new homes listed during the month increased **9.2%** from December 2018 to December 2019.

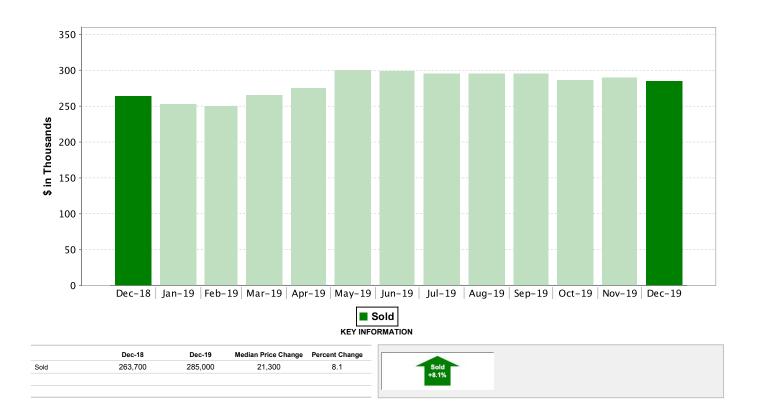

The median price of sold homes during the month increased **8.1%** from December 2018 to December 2019.

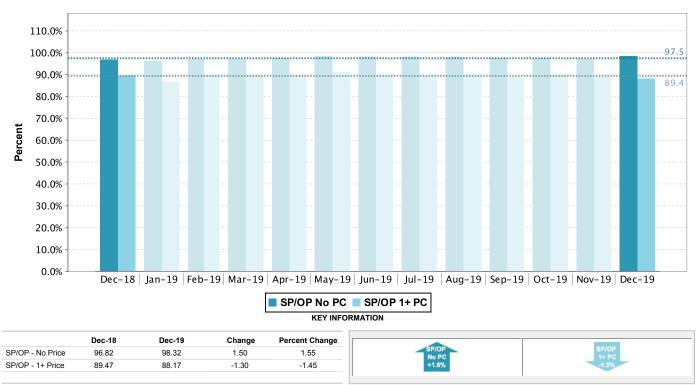

### Average Sale Price/Original Price Comparison

No Price Changes — December 2018: 96.8% vs. December 2019: 98.3% 1+ Price Change — December 2018: 89.5% vs. December 2019: 88.2%

On average, properties sold within **98%** of the original list price in December 2019 if there was not a price adjustment during the listing period, reflecting an increase of **1.6%** from December 2018. Properties that experienced one (1) or more price change in December 2019 sold at approximately **88%** of the original list price, reflecting a decrease of **1.5%** when compared to the same time period last year .

### Supply & Demand − # of Units

For Sale — December 2018: **5,693** vs. December 2019: **4,249** Under Contract — December 2018: **696** vs. December 2019: **1,040** Sold — December 2018: **782** vs. December 2019: **919** 

The number of properties for sale decreased **25.4%** in December 2019. The number of sold properties increased **17.5%**, while properties placed under contract during the month increased **49.4%** when compared to the same time period last year.
