ONE SOTHEBY'S PARTICIPATES IN SOTHEBY'S RECORD BREAKING CONTEMPORARY ART AUCTION

Sunday November 18th, 2012

On November 13th, Sotheby's in New York City held its Contemporary Art Auction that included masterpieces by artists Mark Rothko, Willem De Kooning, Jackson Pollack and Francis Bacon among others.
