View | From the front door, one can appreciate the porch with room for a chair. Beyond the porch is a quiet cul-de-sac with minimal traffic. In the backyard, one feels tranquility taking in a variety of trees. Birds can be heard singing and squirrels scurry the fenceline. The afternoon sun shines warmly.

Room | The living room offers a cozy feeling with a fireplace and space to unwind. The kitchen is a happy place. Many meals have been made to be shared around the dinner table. The evening light comes in just right. It is also wonderful to look out the kitchen window to take in the birds and breeze flowing through the trees.

Tree | We have 2 towering pine trees in our backyard offering some shady spots. There is also a cherry blossom tree that fills beautifully in the spring. As a whole, the neighborhood is green and luscious.

Walk | Walking through the neighborhood can take one to so many places! There are sidewalks leading into downtown Cary. It is easy to get to the dog park to grab a drink and watch the dogs play. Not far down the road is Kildaire Lake that makes for a nice 2 mile walk to and from.

Hike | Bond Park is less than 10 minutes away with great views and combination of paved and unpaved pathways. The best hiking is Umstead Park which is 15 minutes away. Endless miles of trails weave through the park as you encounter peace and wildwife along the way. Hemlock Bluffs Nature Preserve is another hidden gem, just 10 minutes away makes you feel like you are in Western North Carolina amongst hemlocks.

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Breakfast | You can never go wrong with a bagel from Big Doms in Downtown Cary or some pastries from Brecotea. If you do not feel like driving Caribou Coffee is a 10 minute walk away. Plume is a fun spot in Downtown Cary. For good southern breakfast, Briggs is about 5 minutes away. For a Saturday morning, it is hard to beat a 20 minute walk into downtown Cary for the farmers market where you can grab some breakfast, coffee and some food for later.

Lunch | We love Sassool, City BBQ, Corbetts or Chido Tacos for a quick and satisfying lunch- all really close by. We also love going to the food court in HMart for lunch before we shop for items to make a meal for later. Another fun one is grabbing a slice or two to-go from DiFaras in Cary and walk around the new park.

Dinner | The location of the home is great as we are close to everything. Picking dinner can be overwhelming because there are no shortage of choices walking distance and driving distance. A few favorites walking distance is Istanbul, Szechuan Mansion Hot Pot and Sushi-Thai. Some really good restaurants a short drive away are Bosphorus, Taipei 101, Shinmai Shikudo, Mezcalito and Noodle Boulevard. Raleigh is 15 minutes away with all its amazing restaurants. There are tons of good South Asia restaurants to frequent in Morrisville. Fenton is always so close with a ton of fun spots to chose from.

Pub/Winery | Fortnight Brewery is a 15-20 minute walk from the house. They have a weekly run club, trivia night and always have a food truck outside. The house is within 10 minutes of Downtown Cary which offers some of the best breweries in the area: Bond Brothers and Viscous Fishes. Chatham Street Wine Market, Sidebar, Hearsay, a Cocktail Bar, Happy Bar and the Williams House are off of Chatham Street.
