Breakfast | It's not a fancy place, but we love finding hole in the wall diners. Grill Worx doesn't look like much, but it is a very solid diner and very obviously frequented by long time residents.

Lunch | Our favorite weekend lunch spot was a short drive to Saxapahaw to have a delicious, local meal at Saxapahaw General Store. They also offer many local bakery items, produce, coffee, meat, and treats for sale in the small grocery store area. We would also stop by Left Bank Butchery for absolutely amazing locally raised meats to take home and savor.

Dinner | Our favorite dinner spot, especially for an adult meal, was Spenser's Tavern in the Historic Colonial Inn. It was especially nice that you can take backroads to get there! The ambiance was so peaceful and in a charming restored historic hotel.

Pub/Brewery/Winery: | Not far away from the house is Eno River Brewery. It is an excellent place to hang out, bring your own snack and enjoy nature. It's a great stop for bikers and hikers as it is immediately off of the Riverwalk!
