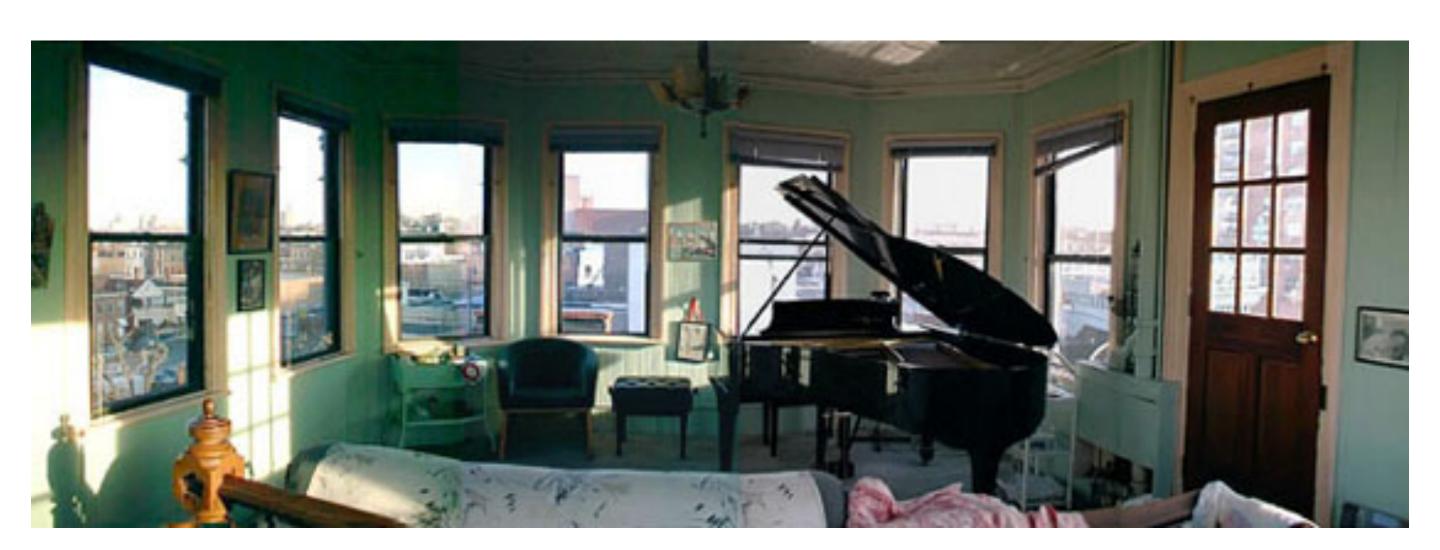




William B. Cronyn House

271 Ninth Street

Since 1981, this French Second Empire house has been home to Vita and Charles Sibirsky's Slope Music, yet its story stretches back much further. Built in 1856 for Wall Street merchant William B. Cronyn, it later served both as a family residence and the headquarters of Higgins American India Ink. A rare surviving example of mid-19th-century architecture, the building is distinguished by its projecting bays, mansard roof, and distinctive cupola. Painted a striking blue, it earned the affectionate nickname the "Blue Belle of Brooklyn." Today, as both a designated NYC Landmark and a listing on the National Register of Historic Places, it endures as a beloved neighborhood icon. According to the Department of Finance, its current market value is \$6.48 million.

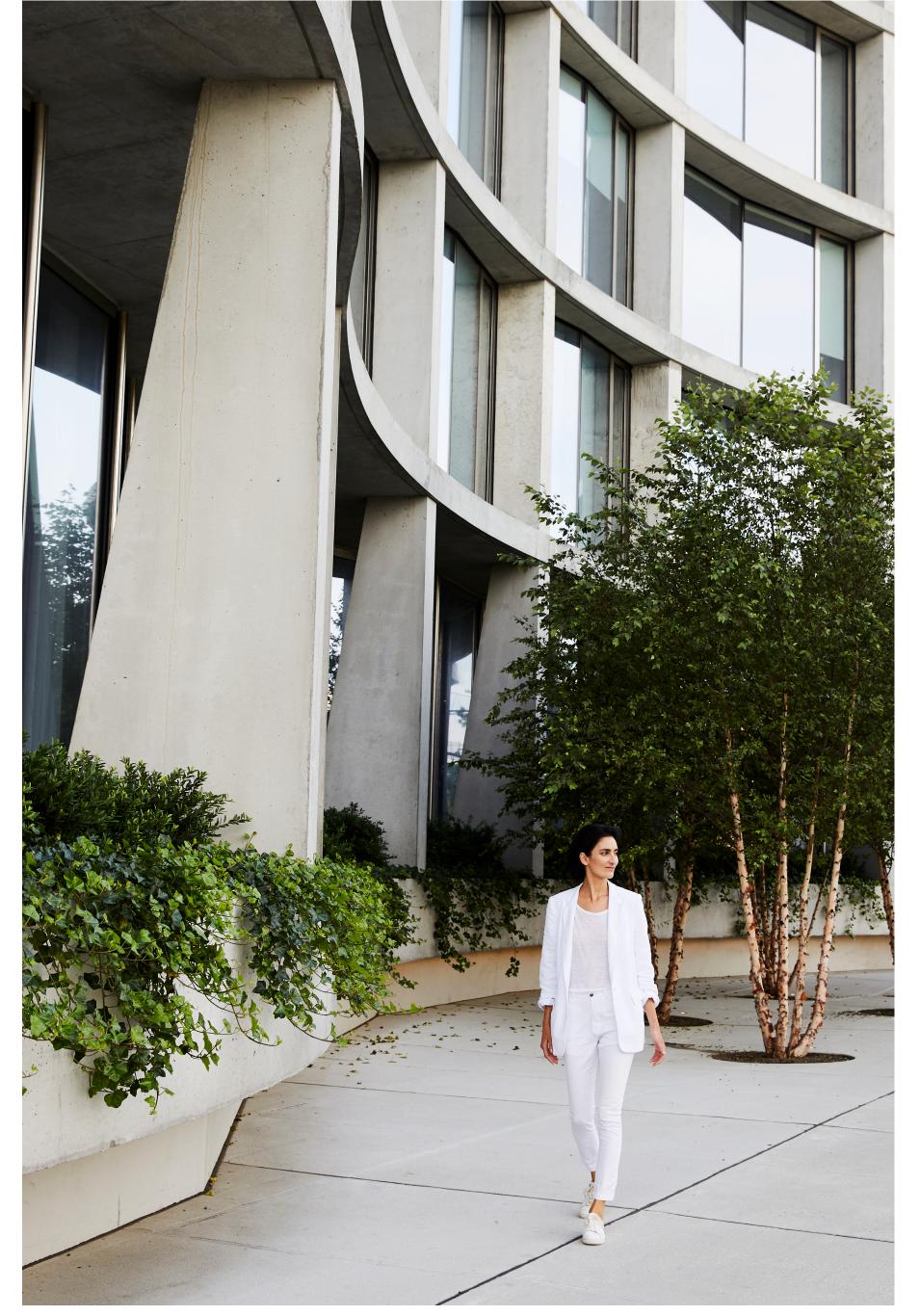
