




















Main Level Floor Plan


Second Level Floor Plan

About The Neighbourhood

The area and neighbourhood boasts a rich history. Vineland, Ontario, began as Orange Center, settled by Mennonites from Pennsylvania, but was officially named Vineland in 1894 and grew around the establishment of the Vineland Experimental Farm, becoming a hub for tender fruit farming and winemaking in the Niagara Region. A post office was established in 1894, and the area officially became “Vineland,” likely named for its vineyards. Vineland remains a major center for tender fruit production and grape growing in the Niagara Peninsula, known for its farms and wineries.

Kacaba Vineyards Winery is located on prime grape growing acreage, directly across from this home, on the Niagara Escarpment Bench in Vineland, Ontario. The Escarpment is actually the slope leading to the lake bed of the prehistoric lake that covered southern Ontario.

If you follow the Wine Route into Vineland, the gate to Kacaba winery is flanked by Niagara ledge rock and leads up a curved driveway lined with Sugar Maples. Once you are up there, the skyline of Toronto is visible across Lake Ontario, making this neighbourhood prime for year round hiking!

This is considered to be one of the nicest spots on the Escarpment and visitors are surprised and charmed to experience such a nice example of agricultural activity close to urban areas. A true preserve.

Lincoln's own Restaurant Pearl Morissette received its second Michelin Star and the prestigious Michelin Green Star for sustainable gastronomy, making this a popular location destination.
