

KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT THE FIRST, N.A., a national banking corporation, of Damariscotta, Maine for consideration paid, grants to F. G. MANAGEMENT, LLC, a Maine limited liability company, with a mailing address of 370 Colonia Blvd., Colonia, N.J. 07067, with quitclaim covenant, the land situated on the southwesterly side of U.S. Route 1-A (190 Bangor Road) in the City of Ellsworth, County of Hancock and State of Maine, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a bolt set in the ground on the southwesterly side of U.S. Route 1-A at the easterly corner of, land described in deed from Raymond A. Applebee to Richard L. McDonald dated/July 17, 1989 and recorded in the Hancock County Registry of Deeds; thence South 39° 02' East by and along the southwesterly side of U.S. Route 1-A, two hundred-forty nine (249) feet to a bolt set in the ground marking the easterly corner of land described in deed from Richard L. McDonald to Vance B. Gray, Sr. dated July 20, 1989 and recorded in the Hancock County Registry of Deeds in Book 1762, Page 418; thence South 49° 32' 10" West by and along land of Gray, aforesaid, 87.43 feet to a point which is North 40° 27' 50" West, 2.1 feet from the center of a drilled well casing; thence continuing same course (S. 49° 32' 10" W.) by and along land of Gray, aforesaid, one hundred seventy-seven and seventy-two hundredth's (177.72) feet to a bolt set in the ground; thence continuing same course (South 49% 32' 10" West), fifteen (15) feet, more or less, to the center of Dunham Brook, so-called: thence generally northerly, westerly, northerly and easterly and along said Dunham Brook, seven hundred forty (740) feet, more or less, to the southerly-line of land described in deed from Emma M. Haves to Fred W. Lakin dated September 19, 1934 and recorded in Book 647, Page 135, and devised to Ruth M.
